



Skiing for Upper Limb Amputees

TRS Downhill Racer

This lightweight terminal device was designed primarily for alpine (downhill) skiing but has been successfully applied to Nordic (cross-country) skiing. It is also applicable to mountaineering and hiking/climbing poles or sticks for use in the summer and other seasons. The poles snap in and pop out for safety and convenience. Sized for pediatric to adult.

This terminal device can be used passively with or without a cable. It's especially useful for Nordic skiing where upper-body power is required, and in alpine mogul skiing. Sized for youth to adult.
