



Pool, Billiards or Snooker Devices for Arm Amputees

The **Hustler**, by TRS, is a versatile, lightweight prosthetic adaptor for playing pool, billiards, snooker and similar table games.

The **Hustler** can be easily adjusted manually for all types of shot angles. The rigid, rubber tipped base creates a non-slip bridge while the swivel ring guides the stick almost friction free.

One amputee customized the **Hustler** to suit his own personal needs by adding an insert into the white ring to reduce the amount of movement of the cue within the holder.

The **Cue Rest**, from Steeper, is screw threaded and connects to the prosthesis with an adaptor plate. Designed to support the cue, this device has a rotating head to provide a stable base, with three different heights.

The **Pinch Hitter**, by TRS, is flexible enough to be placed almost anywhere on the pool or billiards cue handle. Its snug fit duplicates the type of fluid wrist action required to perform a smooth shot with proper follow through.

The **Pinch Hitter** can be used by persons with either a right or left hand absence.
