



## Drumming Aids

There are a variety of innovative attachments available for upper limb amputees interested in playing the drums.

An inventive father designed this special device for his son which quite simply is a modified store bought drum stick that attaches to a standard hook prosthesis. It is lightweight and provides excellent control.



This curved device attaches to a standard wrist unit and holds the drum stick in place.



This attachment fits over the fingers of a passive hand to hold the drum stick.



For partial hand amputees, this simple spatula device allows the drum stick to be held between the hand and the pad on the device.

For the more difficult beats, this semi-custom device by TRS allows the drum stick(s) to pivot enabling the drummer to create drum rolls. The drum sticks need to be modified by TRS to ensure proper function.
